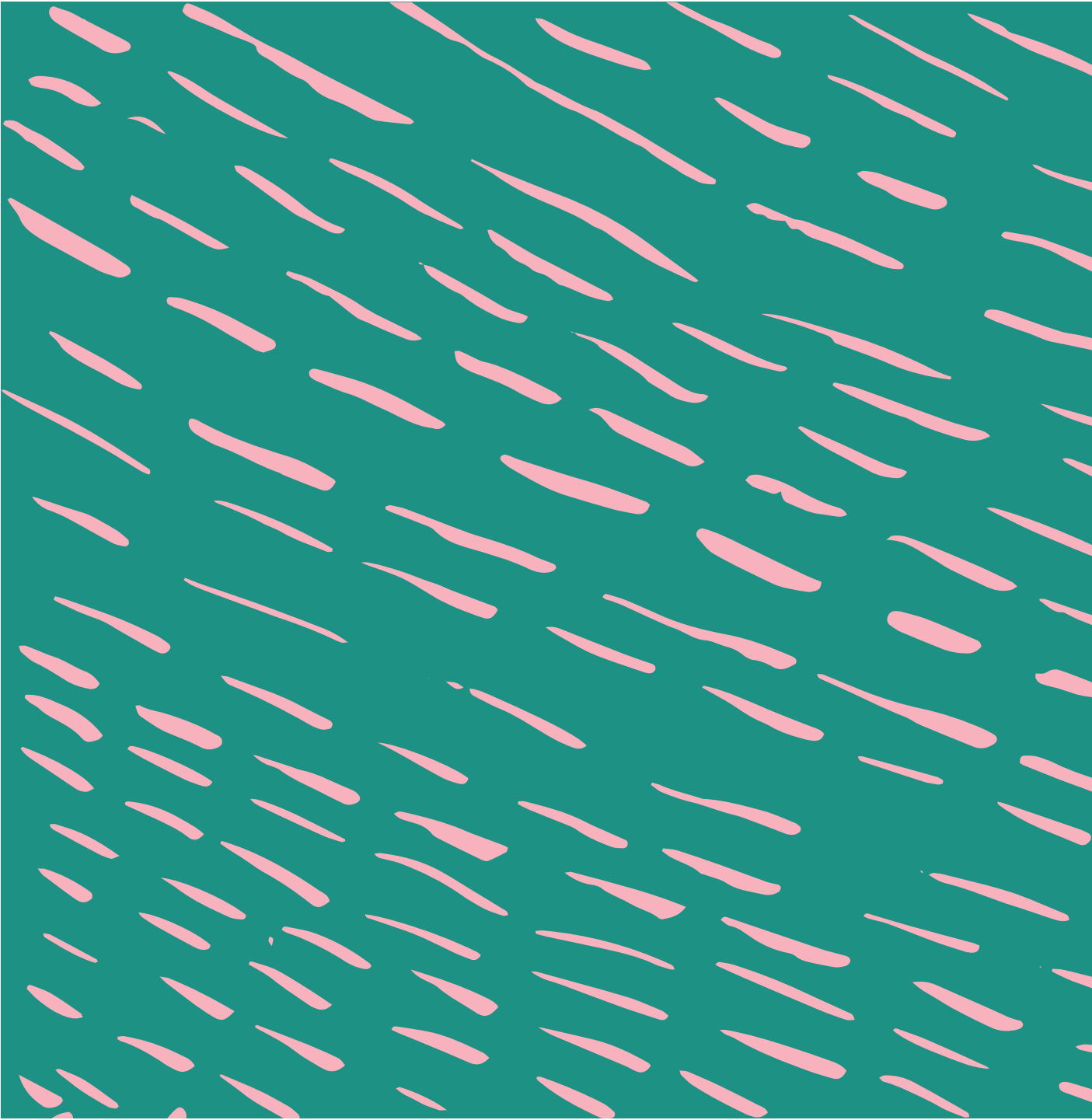

Craft Lager

Not all lagers are born equal. Not all lagers are boring and mass produced.

This category provides a range of beers that still have the characteristic light colour and easy drinking style of lager, but take it up a notch with their flavour profile. Given that over 90% of all global beer consumed is lager, this range provides the perfect temptation for someone new to the craft beer scene.

Mondo



Founded in 2014, American brewers Todd Matteson and Thomas Palmer brought their night shift musings into the light, and after picking up experiences across the globe, Mondo Brewing was born.

Their friendship was underpinned by the place they once called home – America – but took root in Battersea, London.

They expanded significantly early in 2019 and are now set to extend their reach from North to South, with their beer now pouring in mainland Europe, Scandinavia, Australia and the East Coast of America.

Mondo's flagship IPA is the Dennis Hopp'r, a light and fruity beer with well balanced hops and malt. Exciting aromas on the nose transfer to the smooth and clean palate, which has notes of pine and citrus balanced by a caramel malty backbone.

One of the more renegade expressions in their portfolio is the Little Victories Session IPA.

This thirst-quencher has tropical fruits in abundance, with the aroma and palate a flourish of freshly cut pineapple and mangoes, with a citrus freshness and a faint caramel malt.

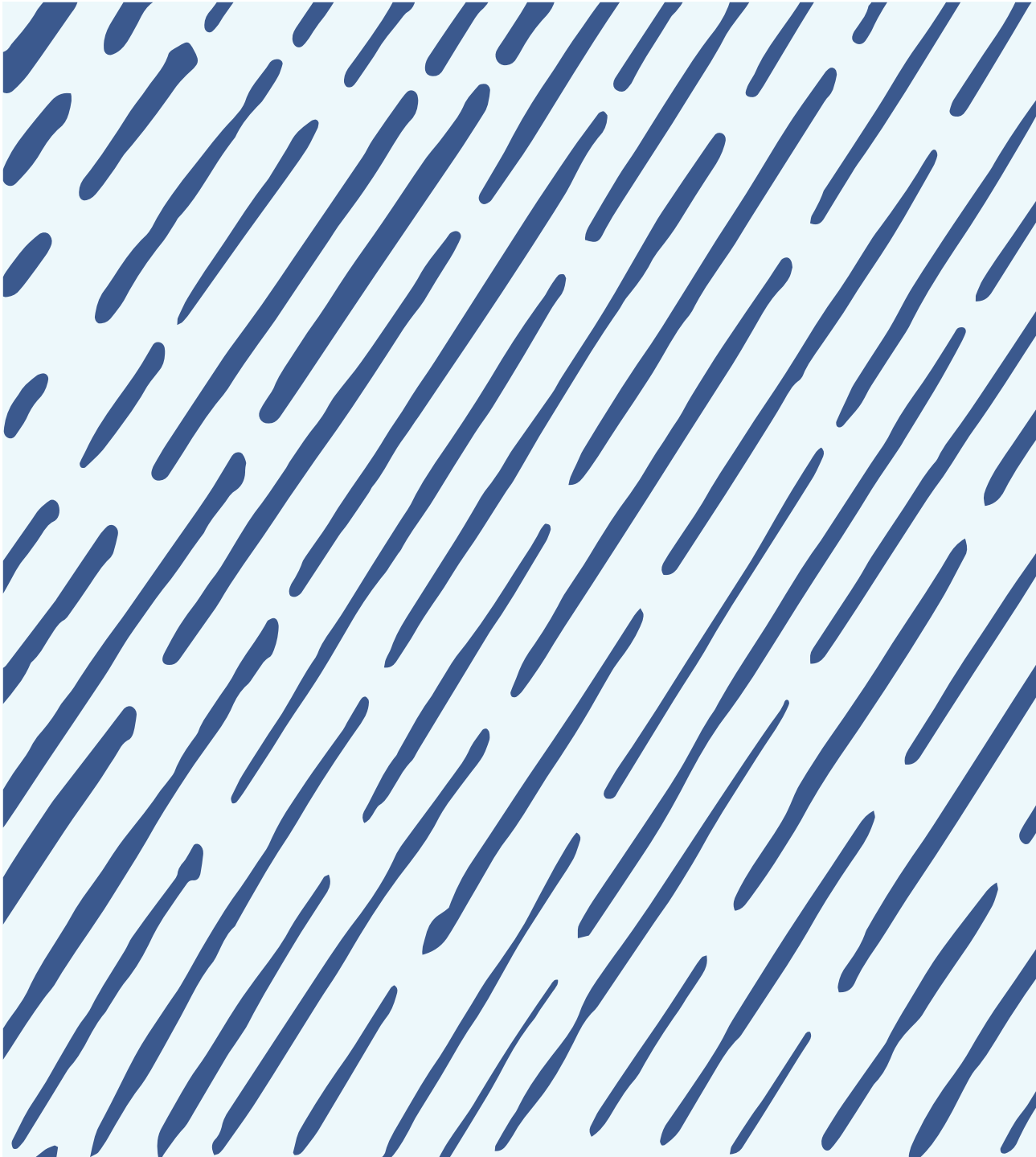

Session IPA

Session IPAs have a similar overtly hoppy aroma to IPA but with toned down alcohol levels, meaning you can enjoy even more of them!

It is believed they were created for British workers back in the early 1900s who were allowed to drink on the job, therefore needing a lower alcohol beer so they could still function...

Crate



CRATE has grown from a modest 1,600 litre a week brewery to a team of seven, brewing hard to satisfy the ever-growing demand for their oh-so-drinkable beers.

Starting its journey on the banks of Hackney Wick, CRATE was founded by three long-term residents and friends. Initially a pizza restaurant and microbrewery, it has grown exponentially but has still kept its homegrown roots, working closely with customers to help and advise. The team use the finest British malts and international hops, coupling these ingredients with traditional brewing techniques and the latest innovations. With a total focus on flavour and aroma, they produce bold

beers that are ever-evolving, in constant pursuit of the perfect pint. A point of differentiation for CRATE is their range of sour beers and ciders, which they produce alongside their IPA. Their NRB cider is made of a blend of Somerset vintage cider and dessert apples, which is then fermented in oak vats that are almost 100 years old. The result is crisp and refreshing. The Citra Sour beer is a lip-smacking refreshing sour, which has juicy citrus notes from yuzu fruit, which is coupled perfectly with a generous dose of citra dry hop. Their IPA is complex and bold, with an abundance of juicy hops, a subtle caramel note and a toffee malt backbone.

Pale Ale

Improved kilning techniques allowed brewers to create a pale amber-coloured beer using lightly roasted malts, leading to the creation of pale ale.

Nowadays this category is booming and varies in style hugely. You'll find pale ales dominating all beer lists due to their popularity. Generally lighter in alcohol but still packed with flavour.

Northern Monk



From brewing in a parent's cellar in 2013, founders Russell Bisset and Brian Dickson grew their operation and relocated to Leeds, where they create their beers across two sites.

The first is the original brewery at the Old Flax Store, where they began their journey in 2014, and is home to their LDS tap room. They expanded into a second much larger brewery, Sydenham Road, in April 2017. Between both sites they can brew up to 18 beers at a time.

Northern Monk are committed to working with charitable organisations, local businesses and anyone who shares

their passion for detail and respect for humanity and its natural resources. They regularly collaborate with breweries and businesses from near and far, to help strengthen the North for positive change and to continually diversify their offering.

Of their core range, a call-out must go to their award-winning Eternal Session IPA. Awash with delicate notes of caramel from pale malts and backed up by grapefruit and resinous notes from a generous dry-hopping with US hops, this is a complex drop. It has a body and flavour profile that goes on and on, to eternity.

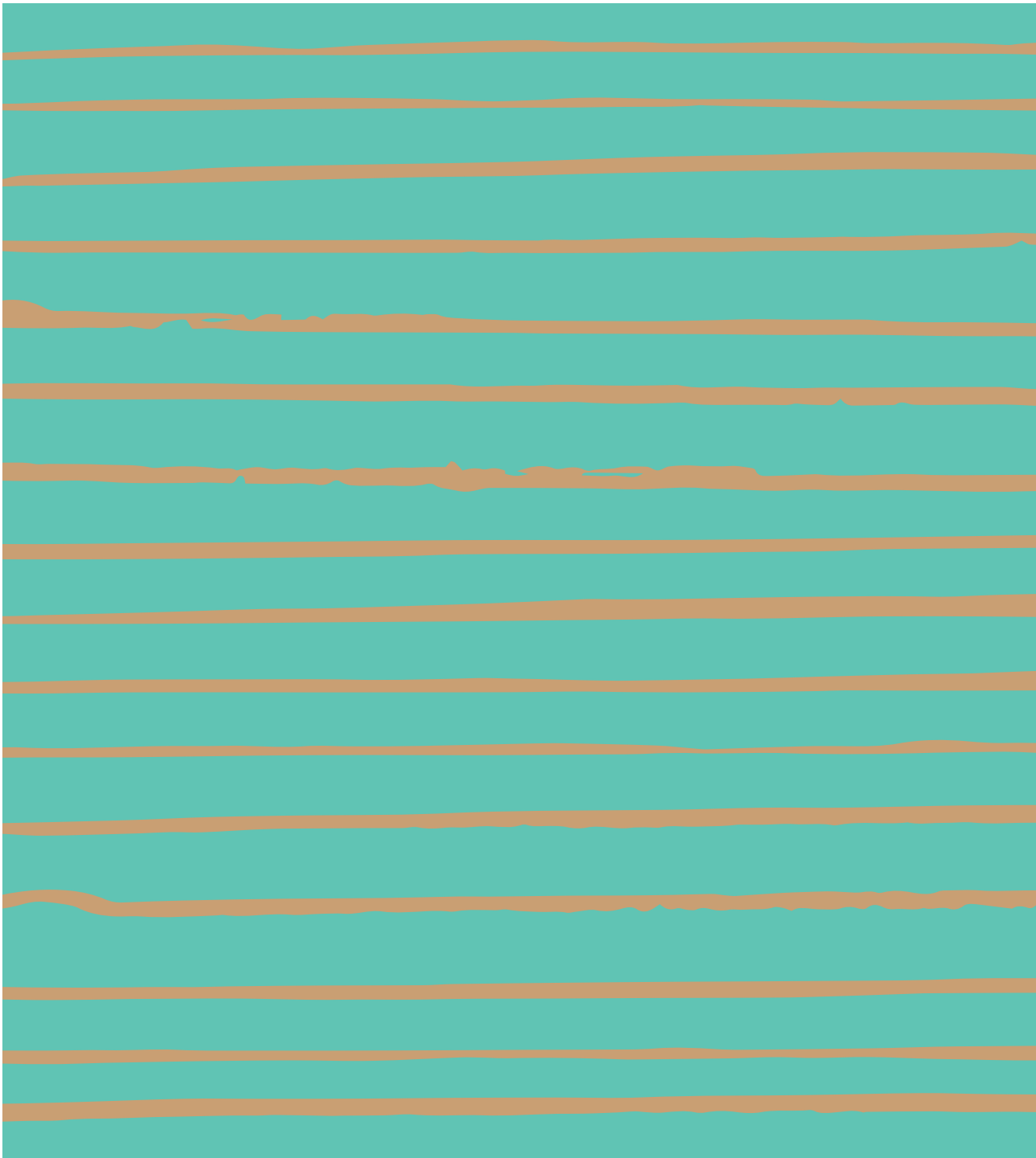



Brewboard



Founded by Stuart Chambers, Paul Archer and Oliver Pugh in 2017, the Brewboard philosophy is simple - to produce craft beers that they enjoy drinking and that the public will too. Their beers are all unfiltered and unfined, packed full of flavour and aroma.

Although their brewing is rooted in established and traditional techniques, the beers are modern, intuitive and fearless, with a confidence borne out of both knowledge and use of the best ingredients. The branding is immediately eye-catching, with each beer having its own personality and character. This

strong visual identity has enabled them to also capitalise on merchandise, creating a Brewboard community. Their Ripchord Ale is a light gold multi-hopped session pale ale imparting a seriously good tropical tang and rich malty flavour. The Cardinalred is a deep russet, multi-hopped Amber Ale, with a spice infused hit from the hops and a malty backbone. For the stout lovers, there is a magically modern expression with rich nut and coffee bean flavours. The range lightens up with their pale ales, like the Huellonbach, a light-gold dry-hopped Oatmeal Pale Ale, featuring Amarillo and Huell Melon flavoursome hops.

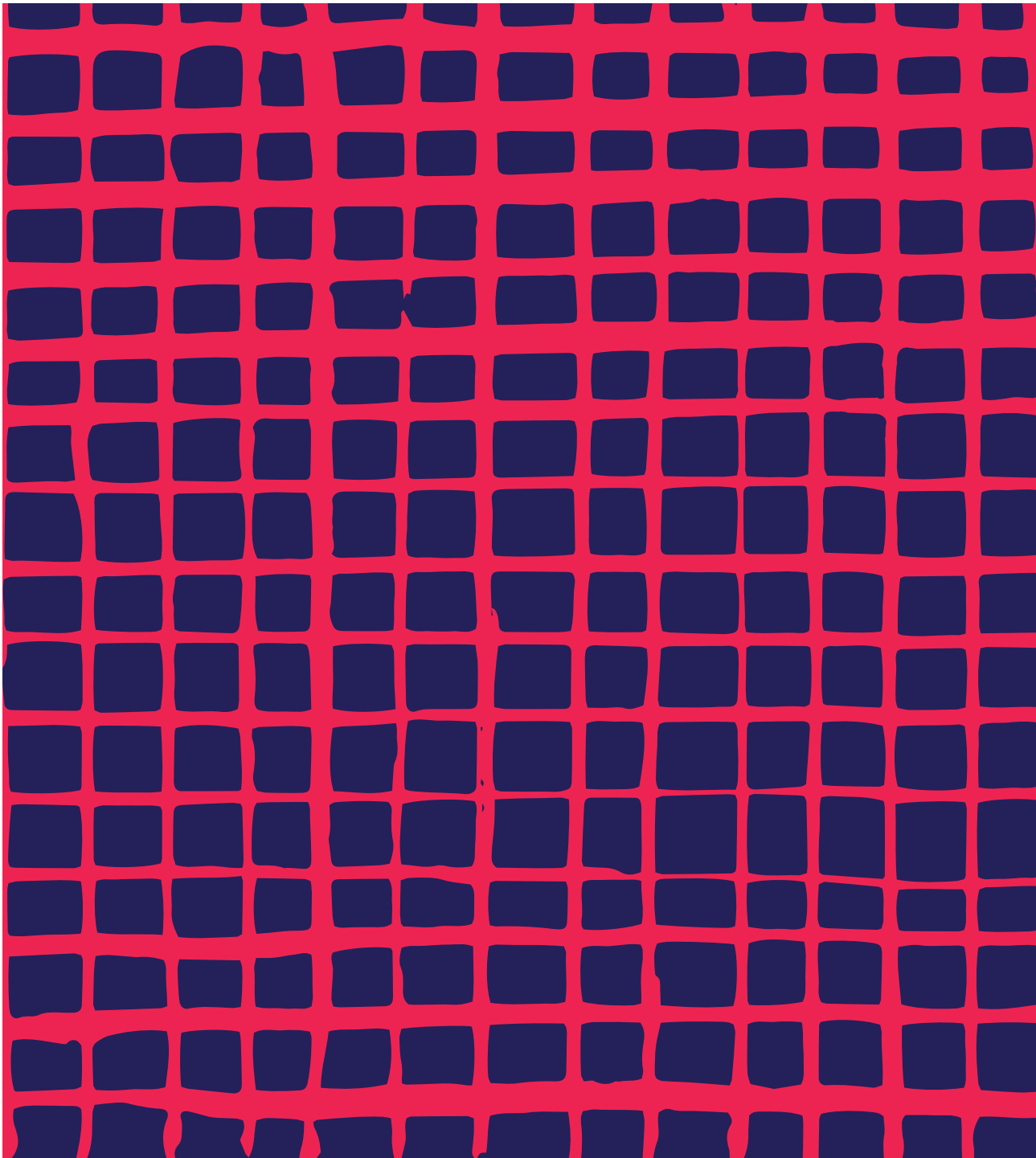



They champion flavour, provenance, consistency and quality, and their range of award-winning beers are unfiltered and unpasteurised for a better flavour and aroma. The beers are inspired by the founders' passion for both the British real ale tradition and the best of the international craft beer movement. The flagship beers are complemented by regular limited and small batch releases, including their barrel-aged project.

They are committed to the local and wider community, and were the first brewery in the UK to be an accredited Living Wage Employer, and they are proud to pay the London Living Wage. All their electricity is sourced from 100% renewable sources. They helped to establish an apprenticeship scheme for training brewers and work to support local charitable, arts and community projects. One of the first brews created, which still uses the same recipe, is their Railway Porter. This is a classic, robust London style porter with a Five Points twist. It's smooth and full-bodied, bursting with aromas of dark, bitter chocolate, and roasted coffee.

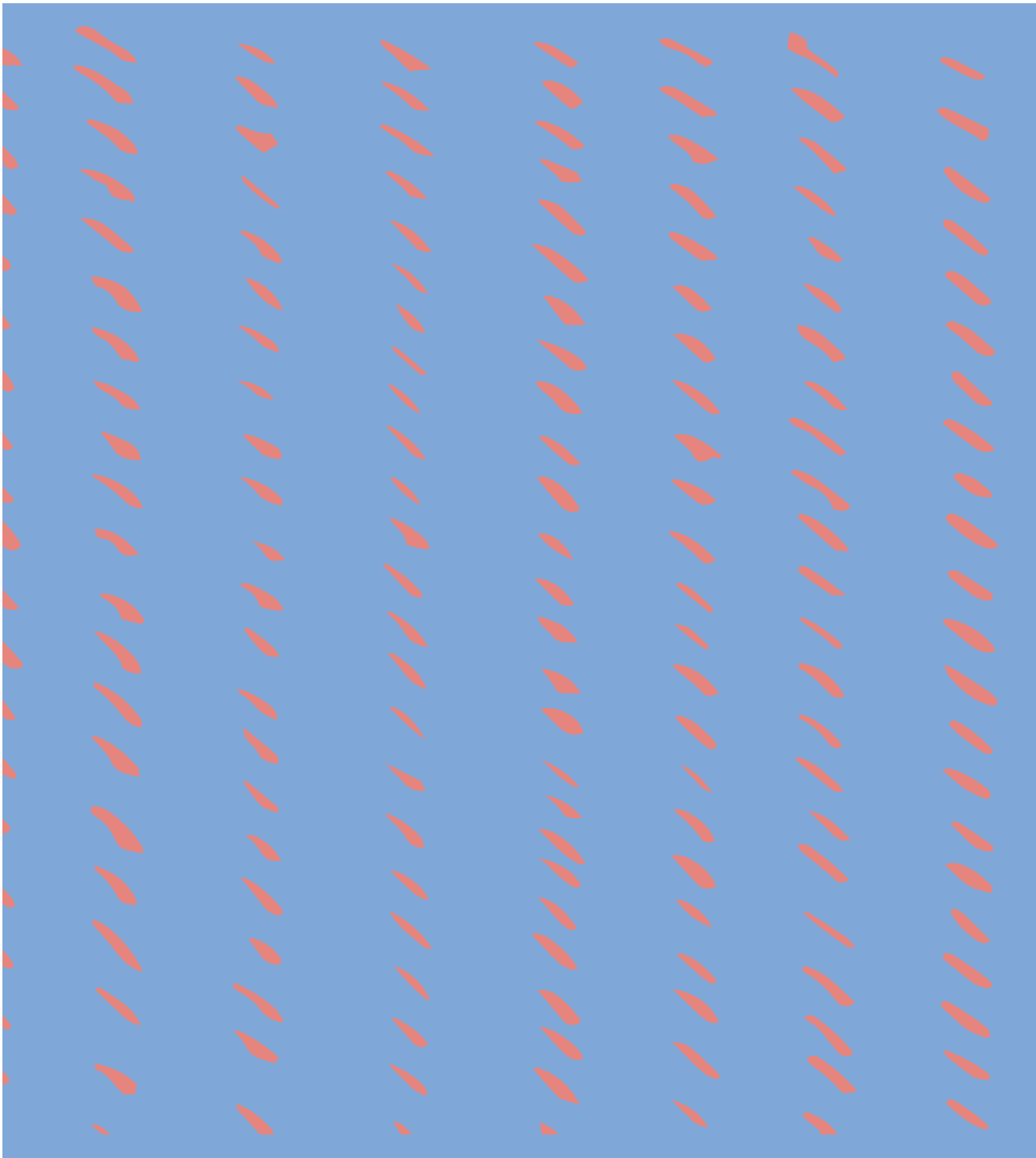

The Edinburgh Beer Factory is a family-run independent brewery, launched in 2015 to make people think again about beer and Scotland. Founded by the Dunsmore family, they have now grown to a broader family of 20+ team members.

Like their home city, they're creative, inventive and outward-looking. They combine old and new ideas and techniques to create beers of beauty. All of their brews are inspired by Edinburgh-born 'Father of Pop Art' Eduardo Paolozzi. Each beer is named after, and inspired by, the Paolozzi artwork that can be seen on their branding.

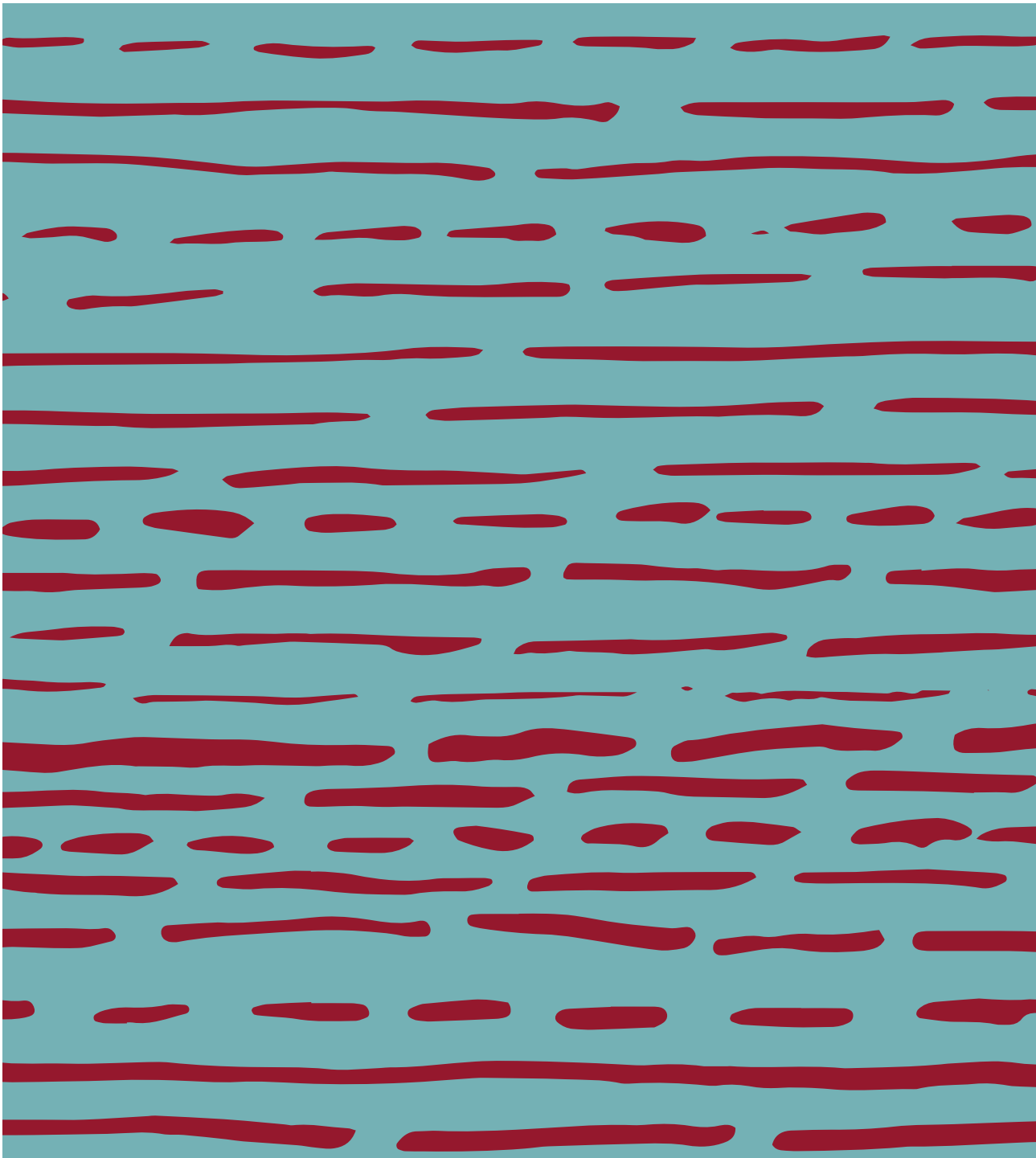
The first brew they created was Paolozzi Lager. In his own words, the artist would reveal the 'sublime in every day,' which is why lager, a common and mass-produced beer style, was chosen as the first brew to be re-vamped. It is brewed with 100% barley malt and 'Munichised' water, and, most importantly, given a proper lagering (cold conditioning) period for 5-6 weeks following fermentation, this Munich Helles style lager beer has a perfect bitter-sweet balance and fabulously sparkling appearance. They don't pasteurise their lager, so it's extra fresh and keeps its natural fullness of flavour.

With the vast number of craft beers available, it's hard to make your range stand out, so stock one of these weird and wonderful beers to add a touch of the unusual to your offering.

Piston Head



The leather jacket-ed, punk-rock rebel of the beer world, Piston Head is a way of life, and they invite the fun, cool and creative to come along for the ride.

Piston Head was borne out of a workshop inside the brewery, where the employees worked on a free-time basis in the evenings and on the weekends, outside of their normal working hours. It is this passion and drive for brewing that continues to drive the company forward today.

All beers in the range are housed in graphic flaming skull-adorned cans, and the stuff inside is just as punchy. Their

no-nonsense Kustom Lager is described as leaving 'a hint of bitterness on your lips, but never in your heart' and has a rich, malty flavour. The Full Amber comes tinged with a hint of grapefruit and buzzing with lively hops. The dry-hopped Flat Tire Lager is gently tinted with fresh floral aromas and tropical fruit, that also comes in a 0.5% abv version. The range is rounded off with their latest addition, Haze Lager. This is crisp and unfiltered, with intense flavours of passion fruit and citrus, and a lessened maltiness.

Beer is no longer off the menu for anyone who is gluten-free.

We've got two fantastic options from Bellfield, who are the UK's first dedicated gluten-free craft brewer. Based in Edinburgh and founded by coeliacs, their mission was to create fantastic tasting beers available to everyone.



Bellfield

Founded by coeliacs, Bellfield Brewery is on a mission to create great tasting, gluten-free beer that anyone and everyone can enjoy, and it is the UK's first dedicated gluten-free microbrewery.

By combining traditional methods with non-traditional ingredients, Bellfield can create small batch beers that have all the flavour you expect, but none of the gluten.

Some breweries produce gluten-free batches of their normal beer by adding enzymes that 'de-glutinize.' Bellfield keep their process natural, adding nothing. They do this by choosing naturally low-gluten ingredients and optimising the

brewing journey in such a way that gluten is removed at each stage.

Bellfield's range currently consists of a classic Pilsner, an aromatic IPA, an extremely moreish Ale, and a refreshingly different Craft Lager. You certainly don't need to be avoiding gluten to appreciate the skill and knowledge that has gone into these fantastic beers.

Using real fruit means that the base ciders vary from batch to batch and season to season. To combat this, the apples are pressed within days of picking then fermented and matured in

their individual varieties, before being meticulously combined to produce the perfect cider every time. Each batch is approved by a taste panel before release to ensure consistency.

The permanent Kentish Pip cider range is periodically joined by intriguing limited edition expressions, which showcase the innovation and excitement within the brand, with experimental flavours and processes being used.

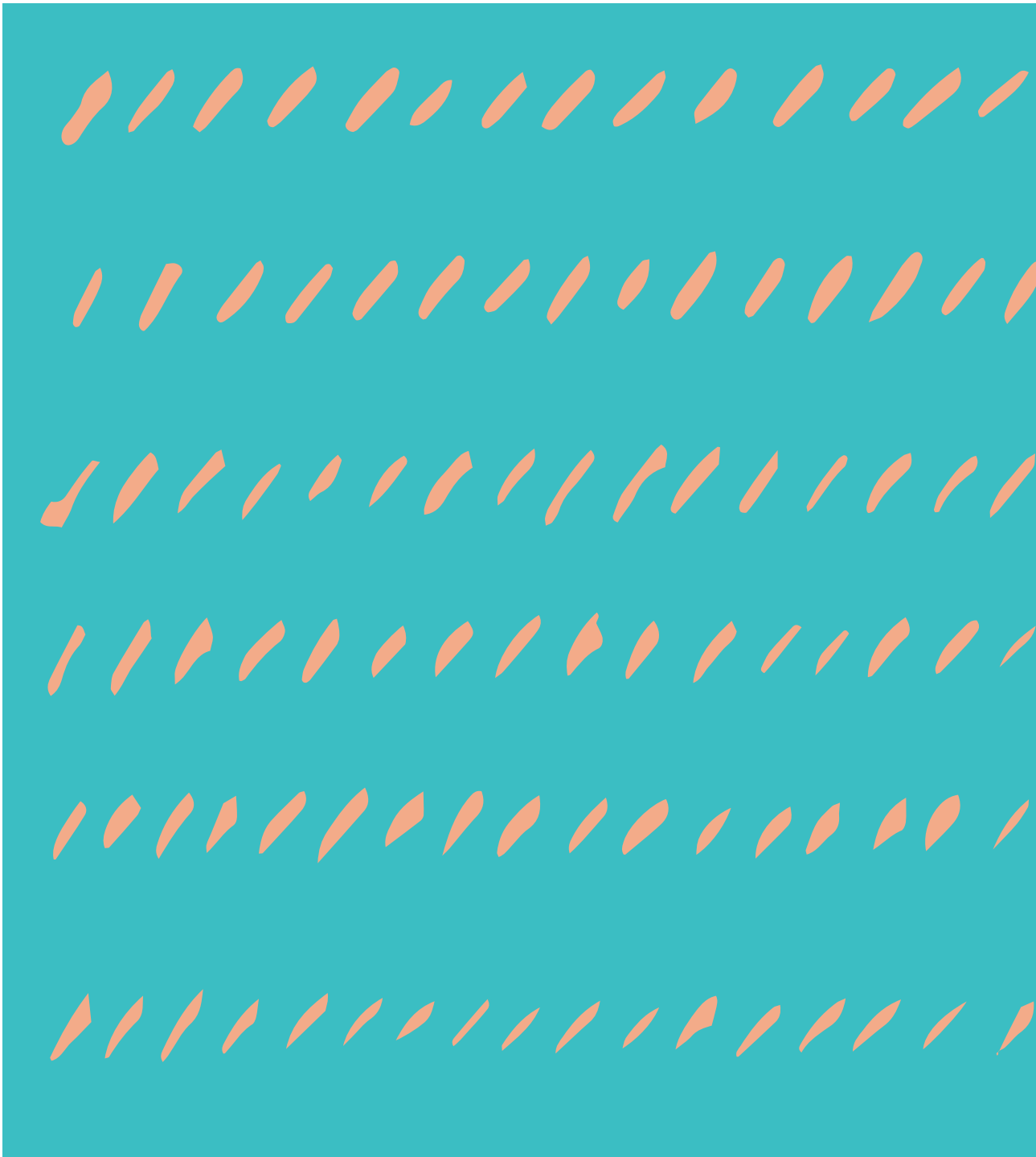

Small Beer



Although a growing trend in this modern age with the health-conscious and tee-totalers, small beer has its origins in the working class of the 17th century, including children! Before the 19th century, poor sanitation meant that drinking water had the potential to cause illness and make people sick.

Fermented beverages, however, were safer to drink. Around this time in the Middle Ages, the small beer was typically brewed at less than 1% abv. So, children drinking beer, and labourers drinking more than ten pints a day, was commonplace.

With the introduction of clean and safe drinking water, small beer fell out of fashion.

It stayed off the radar for a long time, but a recent explosion in the popularity of low/no alcohol drinks has brought it back to the scene.

Felix and James are the duo behind Small Beer Brew Co, the world's first dedicated small beer brewery. Nestled amongst the cultural surroundings of South Bermondsey, the brewing space doubles as a hub for the local community, regularly hosting live music sessions, art exhibitions and local events. Of their original small beers, the Dark Lager comes in with the lowest abv, at just 1.0%. It could almost double up as a dessert with its undeniable chocolaty undertones, and notes of rich coffee and crunchy toast.
