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Château La Gaffelière Bordeaux, France

Owned by the same family since 1705, Château La Gaffelière belongs to the Malet Roquefort family for several generations. This property has the unique distinction of being one of the oldest, family-owned vineyards in the Saint-Émilion appellation of Bordeaux. The family can trace their roots in the Right Bank all the way back to the 1400's. With vines on the premium Saint-Émilion Grand Cru plateau close to Château Ausone and not far from Château Bélair-Monange, this 22-hectare property classified as a Premier Grand Cru Classé is located in the centre of the Saint-Émilion appellation benefiting from a more continental climate compared to the maritime Médoc. La Gaffelière vineyards (Cabernet Sauvignon 5%, Merlot 65%, Cabernet Franc 30%) lie on a sloped sandy/clay-limestone topsoil and limestone subsoil. The family also produces Dame Gaffelière (Second Wine) from their younger vines and Château l'Eglise D'Armens (Third Wine) a more approachable Saint-Émilion Grand Cru.

Château La Ganne Bordeaux, France

Château La Ganne is a 4-hectare family estate located in the south west of Pomerol appellation, owned for four generations by the Dubois family. Vineyard is made of gravel and sandy deposits with a subsoil rich in iron also called "crasse de fer" revealing velvety tannins and its delicate aromas. Nowadays, Paule and Michel Dubois work hard to preserve their legacy. With its 750 hectares, Pomerol is considered to be one of the smallest appellations in Bordeaux's Right Bank but is considered a be one of the most famous in terms of quality.

Aubert & Mathieu is the story of two friends, Anthony Aubert and Jean-Charles Mathieu, who met at school. A few years later, they met up for a drink: Anthony was already in the wine trade and Jean-Charles was in corporate banking. Realising they shared an ambition to make wines their own way, in 2016, they launched Aubert & Mathieu. The first vintage was released in March 2019 and very successful on Paris' trendy restaurant scene. The Aubert et Mathieu identity is based on producing niche wines from the best terroirs of Languedoc-Roussillon while highlighting the nuances and singularities of each appellation. The DNA of their wines show the perfect mastery of freshness, balance and the search for complexity. Inspiration, carefree and a little fantasy led them on their way! Aubert et Mathieu is also completely carbon neutral.

From the classic Pago de Carraovejas in Ribera del Duero, to the cult Verdejos of OSSIAN in Nieva, to Galicia's stunning Emilio Rojo O Gran Mein, they are pushing the quality of Spanish wines to new heights. Having sought counsel from superstars such as Rafael Palacios and Javier Ausas (Vega Sicilia), the baton has been passed to three powerhouse women: Patricia Benitez (Pingus/Vega Sicilia with two 100-point vintages), Almudena Calvo (Spain's top Winemaker 2019) and Laura Montero (Alvaro Palacios, Peter Sisseck). With constant investment, they are continually looking for new projects to improve and become Spain's most sought-after and desired group of wineries.
