From Pinot Noir grapes grown in Sancerre's warmer sites. Transported to the winery and pressed with limited skin contact to give a lighter style of rosé. Fermented, settled and matured in stainless steel.

**Unique Selling Point:**

Will appeal to lovers of Provence Rosé who also like brighter, fresher styles. Light coloured in the Provence style, but with brighter strawberry fruit; from the noble Pinot Noir variety.
